HOW TO: SPEAKIT! FOR ON-LINE TESTING

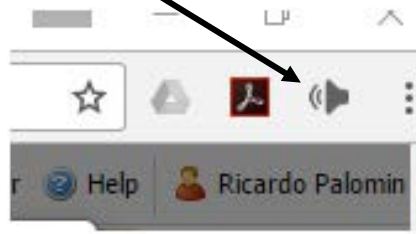
1. **Students log into the assessment with their credentials.**

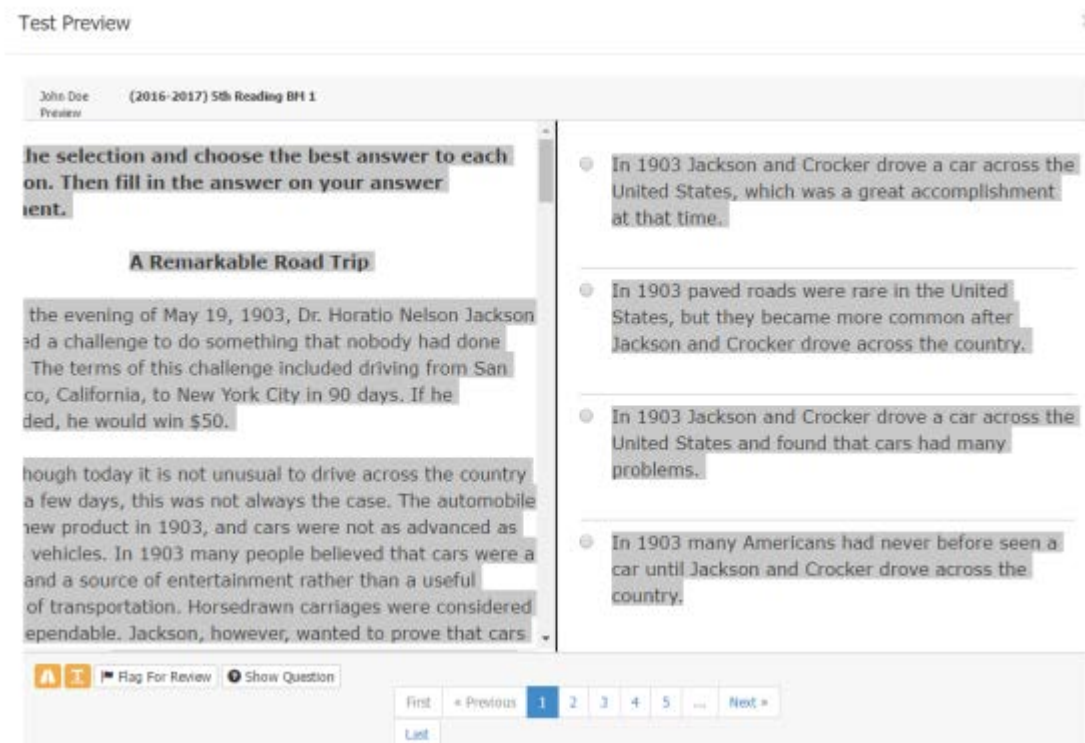
2. **Students highlight the questions and answer choices** they would like to have read to them.
