SISD CURBSIDE MEAL DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM

Dear Sharyland ISD Community,

In light of the current unprecedented event our nation is facing, SISD is advising all stakeholders to stay safe.

On behalf of our Superintendent and Board of Trustees, the Sharyland ISD Child Nutrition Department is committed to ensuring that all children 18 years and under have sufficient opportunities to enjoy a FREE Breakfast and Lunch meal daily.

As we prepare for the closure of instructional campuses district-wide, the child nutrition department has designed a curbside distribution meal program governed by the Texas Department of Agriculture which is organized to provide meals for 7 days' worth.

Effective March 23, all families who have children that are 18 years and under may come to one of our three distribution sites from 11:30 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Both Breakfast and Lunch meals will be provided during your arrival, at NO COST (FREE to Everyone).

We will be serving Monday through Friday from 11:30 a.m. - 1:00 p.m.; any student can visit one of our three locations to pick up their two meals. The locations are as followed:

- Lloyd and Bentsen Elementary (2101 S. Taylor McAllen, TX 78501)
- Jessie Jensen Elementary (510 N. Glasscock Blvd Alton, TX 78573)
- Pioneer High School (10001 N Shary Rd Mission, TX 78572)

To receive a meal, we will NOT require proof of enrollment. TDA guidelines DO require a student to be present to pick-up food. We will serve any child 18 years and younger that is present. No ID is required. All meals are FREE.

*Please stay in your car and we will take the meals to you, curbside. Keep in mind that this is a drive-thru service.

We are thankful for our caring community and our families who are working collaboratively with SISD. We are happy to serve students and do our part in these difficult times. Thank you for your partnership, together we're better even when we are apart.

PROGRAMA DE DISTRIBUCION DE COMIDAS

Estimada Comunidad de Sharyland ISD,

Con motivo del actual evento sin precedentes a la que se enfrenta nuestra nación, SISD está aconsejando a toda nuestra comunidad que se mantengan sanos y a salvo.

De parte de nuestro Superintendente y Mesa Directiva, el Departamento de Nutrición Infantil de Sharyland ISD se compromete a garantizar que todos los niños de 18 años o menos tengan suficientes oportunidades para disfrutar de una comida gratuita para el desayuno y el almuerzo.

A medida que nos preparamos para el cierre de las escuelas en todo el distrito, el departamento de nutrición infantil ha diseñado un programa de comidas de distribución en la acera, el area de descenso y ascenso de los estudiantes. Este programa es gobernado por el Departamento de Agricultura de Texas que junto con SISD administra, y organiza para proporcionar comidas para 7 días.

A partir del 23 de marzo, todas las familias que tengan hijos menores de 18 años pueden llegar a uno de nuestros tres sitios de distribución de 11:30 a.m. a 1:00 p.m. Tanto el desayuno como el almuerzo se proporcionarán durante su llegada, sin costo (GRATIS para todos).

Estaremos sirviendo de lunes a viernes de 11:30 a.m. a 1:00 p.m.; cualquier estudiante puede visitar uno de nuestros tres lugares para recoger sus dos comidas. Las ubicaciones son las siguientes:
